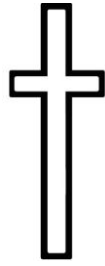

## **GACC KINDERGARTEN**

**“Committed to Shaping the Future”**

The Guardian Angels kindergarten program strives to develop the potential of each child: mind, body, and soul. We are proud of the **CURRICULUM** we offer to our kindergarten students. They receive lessons in religion, handwriting, reading, phonics, math, science and social studies, computer, Spanish, physical education, and music.



For **RELIGION** we use the series Blest Are We! The students attend Mass once a week with the entire Guardian Angels/Central Catholic student body. The children are visited weekly by priests from our local parishes.

For **PHONICS / READING** we are using the Houghton Mifflin Harcourt Journeys Reading Program. The program promotes phonics, grammar, vocabulary, and comprehension skills for all students. The Houghton Mifflin Harcourt Journeys Program offers whole group as well as small groups and individualized instruction.

- **Report of the National Reading Panel (2000) concludes that children who are taught phonics early, systematically, and explicitly do better in beginning reading; they also maintain their skills when decoding instruction is followed by the language, content area, and comprehension instruction needed for high-level and long-term reading achievement.**

For **MATH** we use Silver Burdette’s The Path to Math Success. This program helps children develop the math skills foundation they need to succeed in school and for a lifetime.

For **SOCIAL STUDIES** we use Houghton Mifflin’s My World focusing on history, geography, culture, civics and economics.

In **SCIENCE** we use the McGraw Hill series. This series includes science kits with experiments and activities to help the children explore the world around them.

The kindergarten students enjoy some special **ATTRACTIONS**.

1. They participate in different center activities.
2. Twice a month the children participate in Kindergarten Café. They experience hands-on cooking activities to develop counting practice, sensory experiences, nutrition, measurement exploration, following directions, sequencing and independence.
3. Interesting field trips are planned during the year that correlates with the curriculum.
