We'd like to inform you about Central Community College scholarships and deadlines in the spring semester.

1. ACT ADVANTAGE SCHOLARSHIP Deadline: February 15, 2012.

This scholarship is worth \$700 for tuition and based upon an ACT composite score of 21 or above and a minimum grade point average of 2.5. In order to be eligible for the ACT scholarship, prospective students must have submitted their ACT scores and applied to Central Community College. Also prospective students must have submitted their ACT scores to Central Community College. Scholarship application forms for the ACT Advantage Scholarship will be sent directly to the student's home address approximately the 2nd week of January. Funds are limited!

2. GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP: Deadline: March 1, 2012

Applications are available December 1, 2011 at: www.cccneb.edu/financialaid
Students complete one form for all Central Community College scholarships!

3. SUMMER SCHOLARSHIP: Deadline: April 20, 2012

This scholarship is available for current junior and senior students interested in taking a summer course at Central Community College. Students will be asked to supply ACT, COMPASS or ASSET scores for the scholarship; therefore, we recommend early planning in completing an assessment. The guidelines for this scholarship include:

- The award is based on application/review process.
- Students must be attending a high school in the CCC 25 county service area.
- The award is valued up to \$150 dollars in the form of tuition.
- Applications for this award will be available at CCC Admissions Offices, Learning Center locations, and via our website on March 9, 2012.

Please also note: As of January 2011, CCC scholarships will only be granted to US CITIZENS and ELIGIBLE NON-CITIZENS due to state guidelines (LB403).

This one application applies to all CCC general campus scholarships available. This includes scholarships offered by our Foundation, as well as those offered by each of our three main campuses. If you have problems entering your application on the web, use Internet Explorer.

NEED BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

If you wish to also be considered for the need-based scholarships, you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by March 15th. This application is located at www.fafsa.gov.
